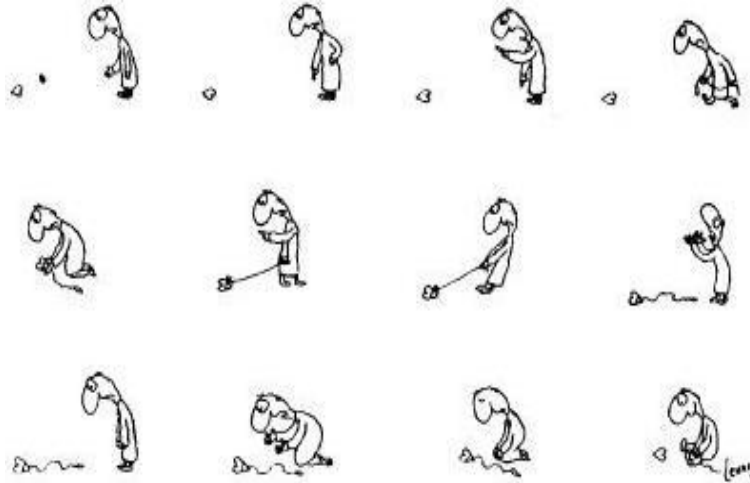


Coming Home
